DIRECTIONS

Preparation:

Apply to surfaces that are clean, dry and free of dust and grease.

Application:

Apply the adhesive two or three times on the surface and join the parts to be bonded together. Close the cap properly after use to avoid drying out of the glue mass. Correction of the bonding parts is possible within a short period of time after bonding. Replace cap immediately after use!

Clean-up:

Water washable. Separation of bonded paper may be aided by steam.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Keep tightly closed and store in a dry and cool place. Avoid temperatures below 5°C and over 50°C. Temperatures over 50°C may cause glue to soften and deform.
